COMMENDING THE EFFORTS OF THE ONE CAMPAIGN AND INVITING ALL
CITIZENS TO JOIN IN RECOGNIZING AND SUPPORTING THE ONE
CAMPAIGN AS IT SPREADS ITS MESSAGE THROUGHOUT THE NATION
AND THE WORLD.

1 WHEREAS, healthy citizens and healthy communities are the
2 centerpieces of any strong and vibrant society; and

4 WHEREAS, residents of Hawaii are among the most generous
5 people in the world; and

7 WHEREAS, it is in the best values of the host culture of
8 Kanaka Maoli and Americans to assist those in need; and

10 WHEREAS, one billion people around the world survive on
11 less than \$1 per day; and

13 WHEREAS, a pact among people of the planet that supports
14 directing assistance and aid for basic human needs--education,
15 health, adequate nutrition, clean water, and care for all
16 children--would transform the futures and hopes of an entire
17 generation in the poorest nations as well as those contributing
18 to positive change; and

20 WHEREAS, ONE is a new effort by Americans to rally all
21 Americans--one by one--to fight the emergence of global AIDS and
22 extreme poverty and is a collaboration of eleven of America's
23 most well-known and respected nonprofit advocacy and
24 humanitarian organizations:


17 WHEREAS, ONE is a new, nonpartisan, political movement

 33 message throughout the nation and the world; and
