## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RELATING TO THE CAUCUS LEADERS AND THE COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS OF  
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TWENTY-THIRD  
LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
2 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
3 of 2006, that BEVERLY HARBIN, who has been duly appointed and  
4 seated as a member of the House of Representatives from the  
5 Twenty-eighth Representative District to fill the vacancy  
6 created by the resignation of former Representative Kenneth T.  
7 Hiraki, shall be an Assistant Majority Floor Leader and a member  
8 of the Water, Land, & Ocean Resources Committee, the Energy &  
9 Environmental Protection Committee, the Hawaiian Affairs  
10 Committee, the Education Committee, and the Higher Education  
11 Committee; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANNE V. STEVENS, who has been  
14 duly appointed and seated as a member of the House of  
15 Representatives from the Twenty-third Representative District to  
16 fill the vacancy created by the resignation of former  
17 Representative Galen Fox, shall be a Co-Minority Whip and a  
18 member of the Labor & Public Employment Committee, the  
19 Transportation Committee, and the Finance Committee; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ROBERT N. HERKES shall: be the  
22 Chair of the Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee; no longer  
23 be the Chair of the Economic Development & Business Concerns  
24 Committee and a member of the Judiciary Committee and the  
25 Tourism & Culture Committee; but remain as a Co-Majority Whip  
26 and a member of the Agriculture Committee and the Economic  
27 Development & Business Concerns Committee; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that JON RIKI KARAMATSU shall: be  
30 the Chair of the Economic Development & Business Concerns  
31 Committee and a member of the Judiciary Committee and the



1 Consumer Protection & Commerce Committee; no longer be the Vice  
2 Chair of the Tourism & Culture Committee and a member of the  
3 Finance Committee; but remain as a Co-Majority Whip and a member  
4 of the Tourism & Culture Committee and the Agriculture  
5 Committee; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that RYAN I. YAMANE shall: be the  
8 Vice Chair of the Legislative Management Committee; and remain  
9 as an Assistant Majority Floor Leader and a member of the  
10 Transportation Committee, the Public Safety & Military Affairs  
11 Committee, and the Finance Committee; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that KYLE T. YAMASHITA shall: be  
14 the Vice Chair of the Tourism & Culture Committee; no longer be  
15 the Vice Chair of the Legislative Management Committee; but  
16 remain as an Assistant Majority Floor Leader and a member of the  
17 Agriculture Committee, the Economic Development & Business  
18 Concerns Committee, and the Finance Committee; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that SCOTT K. SAIKI shall: no  
21 longer be a member of the Consumer Protection & Commerce  
22 Committee; but remain as the Chair of the Hawaiian Affairs  
23 Committee; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that CHRIS HALFORD shall: be  
26 Minority Policy/Legislative Management and a member of the  
27 Health Committee and the Human Services Committee; no longer be  
28 Minority Policy Leader and a member of the Hawaiian Affairs  
29 Committee; but remain as a member of the Agriculture Committee,  
30 the Housing Committee, and the Legislative Management Committee;

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that COLLEEN ROSE MEYER shall: be a  
34 member of the Hawaiian Affairs Committee; and remain as the  
35 Minority Floor Leader and a member of the Water, Land, & Ocean  
36 Resources Committee, the Labor & Public Employment Committee,  
37 and the Finance Committee; and

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that LYNN FINNEGAN shall: no longer  
40 be a member of the Health Committee and the Human Services  
41 Committee; but remain as the Minority Leader and a member of the  
42 Education Committee, the Higher Education Committee, and the  
43 Hawaiian Affairs Committee; and





# H.R. NO. 1
