
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO HONOR
THE FIRST MONDAY IN MAY AS HAWAII HISTORIC PRESERVATION
AWARENESS DAY.

1 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to
2 preserve the architecture, objects, and sites of the numerous
3 cultures that make up our island community; and

5 WHEREAS, preservation of the history of our cultures not
6 only helps to promote the tourism industry, it also helps to
7 preserve for future generations the cultural identities of the
8 various peoples that call Hawaii home; and

10 WHEREAS, historic preservation was recognized as an issue
11 of statewide importance through the proclamation of the
12 Governor, declaring the first Monday in May as Hawaii Historic
13 Preservation Awareness Day, and with the introduction of
14 legislation and resolutions that all seek to support the cause
15 of preservation of historic sites; and

17 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources is
18 charged with administering a comprehensive historic preservation
19 program, including the stimulation of public interest in
20 historic preservation, such as developing and implementing
21 interpretive programs for historic properties listed on or
22 eligible for the Hawaii register of historic places; now,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
27 of 2006, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is
28 requested to honor the first Monday in May as "Historic
29 Preservation Awareness Day" by holding events and activities
30 that will stimulate public interest in historic preservation;
