
HOUSE RESOLUTION

HONORING DR. ED CADMAN FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE JOHN A.
BURNS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE.

1 WHEREAS, spending time fishing and running mountain trails
2 while growing up in Oregon, DR. ED CADMAN's understanding of the
3 rough terrain and unexpected challenges of life provided him
4 with the determination to run with endurance; and

6 WHEREAS, a graduate of Stanford University and University
7 of Oregon Medical School, DR. ED CADMAN quickly gained a
8 national reputation as a sincere man with heart, vision, and the
9 ability to unite others as he served as a professor, Chairman,
10 and Dean of medicine at the Yale Medical School and chief of
11 staff at Yale New Haven Hospital; and

13 WHEREAS, in 1999, DR. ED CADMAN accepted a position as the
14 Dean of the John A. Burns School of Medicine (JABSOM) at the
15 University of Hawaii (UH), where he would serve as the catalyst
16 between Hawaii's future biotechnological industry and sound
17 medical research; and

19 WHEREAS, DR. ED CADMAN became the driving force behind the
20 successful establishment of JABSOM's new state-of-the-art campus
21 in Kakaako, enabling JABSOM to excel in training new physicians
22 while expanding opportunities for biomedical research; and

24 WHEREAS, research grants and contracts increased by more
25 than 500 percent, from \$3,200,000 in 1999, to nearly \$20,000,000
26 in 2004 under DR. ED CADMAN's leadership and today, about half
27 the practicing physicians in Hawaii are graduates of JABSOM; and

29 WHEREAS, in 2005, after fulfilling his commitment to
30 oversee the development of JABSOM, DR. ED CADMAN graciously
31 stepped down as dean of JABSOM and successfully transferred
32 leadership to interim Dean Dr. Sam Shomaker; and
