## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE CAST AND CREW OF ABC TELEVISION'S  
DRAMA SERIES, "LOST" ON ITS RECENT SUCCESSES IN WINNING  
NUMEROUS ENTERTAINMENT AWARDS.

1           WHEREAS, the incomparable beauty and spirit of the Hawaiian  
2 Islands and its people can be projected to the world through the  
3 talented work of creative media; and

5           WHEREAS, by choosing to film the weekly series in Hawaii,  
6 ABC Television's drama series "LOST," has cast the island of  
7 Oahu and its scenery in a role that is valuable to the  
8 development of the series' dramatic story line; and

10           WHEREAS, the creators and producers of "LOST," including  
11 Executive Producers J. J. Abrams, Damon Lindelof, Bryan Burk,  
12 Carlton Cuse, Jack Bender; Co-Executive Producers David Fury and  
13 Jessie Alexander; Supervising Producer Javier Grillo-Marxuach;  
14 Producers Sarah Caplan and Leonard Dick; and series Producer  
15 Jean Higgins, have raised the standard of television production  
16 by giving viewers very entertaining stories of conflict,  
17 suspense, and humor; and

19           WHEREAS, the cast of "LOST" is a talented ensemble of  
20 principal actors, including Adewale Akinuoye-Agbaje, Naveen  
21 Andrews, Emilie de Ravin, Matthew Fox, Jorge Garcia, Maggie  
22 Grace, Josh Holloway, Malcolm David Kelly, Daniel Dae Kim,  
23 Yunjin Kim, Evangeline Lilly, Dominic Monaghan, Terry O'Quinn,  
24 Harold Perrineau, Michelle Rodriguez, Ian Sommerhalder, and  
25 Cynthia Watros, who have developed a devoted fan base throughout  
26 the world; and

28           WHEREAS, through their individual and collective  
29 involvement in various local events, the cast and crew of "LOST"  
30 have demonstrated their commitment and caring of Hawaii's  
31 community, including efforts to raise funds for the victims of  
32 Hurricane Katrina; and



1           WHEREAS, "LOST" was nominated for twelve Emmy awards in its  
2 first season, and on September 18, 2005, at the 57<sup>th</sup> Annual Emmy  
3 Awards, won six, most notably as "Best Drama Series"--the first  
4 for a show filmed in Hawaii--and for "Outstanding Special Visual  
5 Effects for a Series," shared by kamaaina, Archie Ahuna; and

7           WHEREAS, "LOST" was nominated for three Golden Globe awards  
8 by the Hollywood Foreign Press Association and won the award for  
9 "Best Television Drama" on January 16, 2006; and

11           WHEREAS, "LOST" won the Actor award from the Screen Actors  
12 Guild for "Best Performance by an Ensemble in a Drama Series" on  
13 January 29, 2006; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, "LOST" also won awards from the Producers Guild of  
16 America; Writers Guild of America; American Cinema Editors; Art  
17 Directors Guild; ASCAP Film and Television Music Awards; Prism  
18 Award; Academy of Science Fiction, Fantasy, and Horror Films,  
19 USA; BMI Film and Television Awards; Casting Society of America;  
20 International Horror Guild; Motion Picture Sound Editors, USA;  
21 Satellite Award; Television Critics Association Awards; Visual  
22 Effects Society Award; and Young Artist Award; and

24           WHEREAS, the cast and crew of "LOST" are committed to  
25 sharing their creative, unique, and brilliant talents to create  
26 an entertaining and successful television series that is loved  
27 by people around the world, especially in Hawaii; now,  
28 therefore,

30           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
31 Twenty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
32 of 2006, that this body hereby congratulates and honors the cast  
33 and crew of ABC Television's drama series, "LOST" on its recent  
34 success in winning the 2006 Emmy, Golden Globe, and Screen  
35 Actors Guild Awards, in addition to numerous technical and  
36 critics awards, and extends its best wishes for continued  
37 success and good fortune in all future endeavors; and
