## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALOHA SPIRIT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 5-7.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3           "(b) In exercising their power on behalf of the people and  
4 in fulfillment of their responsibilities, obligations, and  
5 service to the people, the legislature, governor, lieutenant  
6 governor, executive officers of each department, the chief  
7 justice, associate justices, and judges of the appellate,  
8 circuit, and district courts may contemplate and reside with the  
9 life force and give consideration to the "Aloha Spirit"~~[-]~~,  
10 steadfastly asking and contemplating with each of their actions,  
11 including what they think, do, say, or decide, whether that  
12 action:

- 13           (1) Is the truth;  
14           (2) Is fair to all concerned;  
15           (3) Will build good will and better relationships; and  
16           (4) Will be beneficial to all concerned."

17           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
