
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that home prices in
3 Hawaii have skyrocketed in the last few years. Hale Mahaolu is
4 a developer of low-income housing and will be developing Hale
5 Mahaolu Ehiku in two phases. As the first affordable housing
6 project in South Maui, Hale Mahaolu Ehiku will eventually
7 consist of one hundred twelve one-bedroom elderly rental housing
8 units, one three-bedroom manager's unit, an adult day care
9 building, a senior center, an adult residential care home, and
10 related improvements on a six-acre parcel. Hale Mahaolu
11 requires \$1,150,000 for phase one of the housing development.
12 Hale Mahaolu also requires an annual supplemental grant of
13 \$96,000 for its personal care program. The purpose of this part
14 is to appropriate funds to assist Hale Mahaolu.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 as a



1 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Hale
2 Mahaolu for:

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 human services for the purposes of this part.

10 PART II

11 SECTION 3. The legislature finds that Maui Economic
 12 Opportunity Transportation began operations in 1969. With its
 13 fleet of sixty-nine vehicles, it provides a wide range of
 14 transportation services to the elderly, low-income individuals,
 15 persons with disabilities, medically needy residents, preschool
 16 children, and disadvantaged youth on Maui. Maui Economic
 17 Opportunity, Inc., requires \$3,500,000 in funding, which will be
 18 leveraged by the county of Maui and the Harry and Jeanette
 19 Weinberg Foundation for additional funds, to purchase a new base
 20 yard site and for plans, design, and construction of a permanent
 21 transit facility, which is essential to maintaining the



1 facility's primary role as the specialized transportation
2 provider for over seven thousand individuals.

3 The purpose of this part is to appropriate funds to assist
4 Maui Economic Opportunity, Inc.

5 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 as a
8 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Maui
9 Economic Opportunity, Inc., for the purchase of a new base yard
10 site and for plans, design, and construction of a permanent
11 transit facility on Maui.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
13 community services in the department of labor and industrial
14 relations for the purposes of this part.

15 PART III

16 SECTION 5. The legislature finds that Hale Makua is being
17 subject to a new federal mandate to provide a fire sprinkler
18 system throughout the Hale Makua-Wailuku facility that will cost
19 \$500,000 over several years. The sum of \$25,000 is being
20 requested for phase one of the new sprinkler project to identify
21 design plans that meet the new federal requirements, identify
22 additional water resources for the sprinkler system, and develop



1 a project timeline. The purpose of this part is to appropriate
2 funds to assist Hale Makua.

3 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 as a
6 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for Hale
7 Makua to fund phase one of the federally mandated fire sprinkler
8 system in the Hale Makua-Wailuku facility.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10 health for the purposes of this part.

11 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
