
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAGE PLUS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Sage PLUS program provides assistance at no
2 charge to people receiving medicare and medicaid benefits, as
3 well as their families, caregivers, and people on the verge of
4 retirement.

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for
6 operating costs to expand and support the Sage PLUS program on
7 the neighbor islands.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$104,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for
11 operation and delivery of the Sage PLUS program on the neighbor
12 islands.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 health for the purposes of this section.

15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$64,500 or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the
18 recruitment, training, and sustaining of volunteers to augment



1 the Sage PLUS program staff, and for operating costs of the
2 neighbor island Sage PLUS program staff.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 health for the purposes of this section.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
