
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE 2050
SUSTAINABILITY PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 8, Special Session of 2005, required the
2 auditor to prepare the Hawaii sustainability plan to define and
3 implement state goals, objectives, policies, and priority
4 guidelines, implementing some or all of the recommendations of
5 the 2050 task force.

6 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to
7 allow the auditor to prepare the Hawaii 2050 sustainability
8 plan.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to
12 provide additional funding for the Hawaii 2050 sustainability
13 task force to:

- 14 (1) Conduct valuable policy analyses;
15 (2) Gather vital research and data;
16 (3) Conduct broad community outreach and solicit input
17 from all sectors;



- 1 (4) Launch an effective public education and media
2 campaign to educate, engage, and inspire community
3 participation; and
- 4 (5) Make a comprehensive assessment of the feasibility and
5 benefits of establishing "Hawaii" as a brand name with
6 values that will support diverse products and
7 services, other than tourism, in the United States and
8 foreign markets.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the auditor for
10 the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
