# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR CHORE SERVICE PROGRAMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that our elderly and  
2 disabled populations need assistance with household chores.  
3 However, many residents do not have friends or family to assist  
4 them with these routine tasks. Chore services programs enable  
5 these residents to remain in their homes after they can no  
6 longer perform essential housekeeping and related activities,  
7 thereby avoiding premature and costly institutionalization.

8           The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for  
9 chore services programs.

10          SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so much  
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the  
13 purpose of supporting and expanding the chore services program  
14 to provide high quality elder care and services to Hawaii's  
15 elderly and disabled populations.



1           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
