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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 58, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended  
2 by Act 22, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended by amending  
3 section 14 to read as follows:

4 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect ~~[on]~~ upon its  
5 approval; provided that:

6 (1) The amendments made to sections 40-1, 40-4, and 40-6,  
7 Hawaii Revised Statutes, by part I of this Act shall  
8 not be repealed when those sections are reenacted on  
9 June 30, 2005, by section 24 of Act 115, Session Laws  
10 of Hawaii 1998;
