# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 342G-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending the definition of "deposit beverage  
3 container" to read as follows:

4 ""Deposit beverage container" means [~~the~~] an individual,  
5 separate, sealed glass, polyethylene terephthalate, high density  
6 polyethylene, or metal container that is less than or equal to  
7 [~~sixty-four~~] sixty-eight fluid ounces[~~7~~] and used for  
8 containing, at the time of sale to the consumer, a deposit  
9 beverage intended for use or consumption in this State."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

**Report Title:**

Solid Waste Management; Deposit Beverage Container Program

**Description:**

Amends the definition of deposit beverage container to include sizes up to and including sixty-eight fluid ounces, and requires dealers in high-density population areas to operate redemption centers. (SD2)
