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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO A DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL DEFENSE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to direct the  
2 transition to the establishment of a new department of civil  
3 defense to which all powers, responsibilities, and functions  
4 currently assumed by the state department of defense in the  
5 areas of civil defense, disaster relief, and emergency planning,  
6 preparedness, and response shall be transferred.

7           SECTION 2. Section 26-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
8 amended to read as follows:

9           "**§26-4 Structure of government.** Under the supervision of  
10 the governor, all executive and administrative offices,  
11 departments, and instrumentalities of the state government and  
12 their respective functions, powers, and duties shall be  
13 allocated among and within the following principal departments  
14 that are hereby established:

1           SECTION 3. During the interim period before the 2007  
2 legislative session the governor shall prepare an organizational  
3 and functional plan for the new department and a plan for the  
4 orderly transition of the functions transferred by this Act.  
5 The governor shall be assisted by a task force appointed by the  
6 governor, consisting of representatives of the state department  
7 of defense, the civil defense advisory council, the office of  
8 disaster relief, the civil defense agency of each county, the  
9 citizen's advisory commission on civil defense, and the United  
10 States Departments of Defense and Homeland Security. The  
11 organizational and functional plan, including any necessary  
12 proposed legislation, shall be submitted to the legislature no  
13 later than thirty days prior to the convening of the 2007  
14 regular session as part of the executive budget request.

15           SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

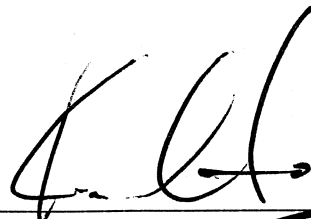
17           SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval  
18 and shall be repealed on July 1, 2007, in the event that the  
19 legislature fails to enact a law establishing the powers,  
20 duties, and other provisions of the department of civil defense
