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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section in part IV to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§201G- Temporary emergency housing. (a) In addition  
5 to any other duties prescribed by law, the administration shall  
6 develop in consultation with the four counties a procedure for  
7 identifying locations that shall be used for temporary emergency  
8 shelters for homeless individuals and families. The  
9 administration shall actively partner with and monitor the  
10 efforts of the counties.

11 (b) Each county shall be responsible for partnering with  
12 non-profit organizations to locate, designate, and maintain the  
13 areas that shall be used for temporary emergency shelters. The  
14 designated locations may include private, county, and state  
15 lands, and federal lands at Kalaeloa.

16 (c) The administration shall pursue and secure Barbers  
17 Point Barracks as temporary housing for homeless families and  
18 individuals.



1       (d) The administration shall submit an annual report to  
2 the legislature detailing the activities and outcomes under this  
3 section no later than twenty days prior to the convening of each  
4 regular session."

5       SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to assist  
8 the counties in implementing section 201G- (b), Hawaii Revised  
9 Statutes, and this Act:

15       The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
16 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.

17       SECTION 3. The sums appropriated under section 2 of this  
18 Act shall constitute the State's share of the cost of mandated  
19 programs under Article VIII, Section 5, of the State  
20 Constitution.

21       SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general  
22 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sum or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to assist  
2 the administration in implementing section 201G- (c), Hawaii  
3 Revised Statutes, and this Act:

4 Hawaii public housing administration §

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
6 human services for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020;  
9 provided that sections 2 and 3 shall take effect on  
10 July 1, 2020; and provided further that this Act shall be  
11 repealed on June 30, 2009.
