
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this section,
3 are hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State
4 of Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007:

 15 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
 17 be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, are appropriated or
 18 authorized, as the case may be, from moneys in the treasury
 19 received from federal grants and revenue bond funds to finance
 20 the following projects on Oahu. The letter symbols used after
 21 the specific project appropriations indicate the source of



1 financing and have the following meaning: (E) revenue bond
2 funds, and () federal funds.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended, and the bonds
8 authorized shall be issued, by the department of transportation
9 for the purposes of this section. Any unexpended or
10 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act as of
11 the close of business on June 30, 2008, shall lapse into the
12 fund from which appropriated. Any unissued balance of any
13 authorization made by this section as of the close of business
14 on June 30, 2008, shall lapse.

15 SECTION 4. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, are appropriated or
17 authorized, as the case may be, from moneys in the treasury
18 received from special funds and the general obligation bond fund
19 to finance the following projects on Oahu. The letter symbols
20 used after the specific project appropriations indicate the
21 source of financing and have the following meaning: (B) special
22 funds, (C) general obligation bond fund.

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended, and the bonds
 5 authorized shall be issued, by the University of Hawaii for the

 7 balance of any appropriation made by this Act as of the close of
 8 business on Jun 30, 2008, shall lapse into the fund from which
 9 appropriated. Any unissued balance of any authorization made by
 10 this section as of the close of business on June 30, 2008, shall
 11 lapse.

12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
