
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS AND RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§92- Exemption; neighborhood boards. Chapter 92 shall
5 not apply to neighborhood boards. Notwithstanding any provision
6 contained in this chapter to the contrary, open meeting
7 requirements, and provisions regarding enforcement, penalties,
8 and sanctions, as they relate to neighborhood boards or any
9 board members shall be prescribed by the respective ordinances,
10 rules, or procedures of the county council, neighborhood
11 commission, or neighborhood boards, which ordinances, rules, and
12 procedures shall take precedence over this chapter. Similarly,
13 provisions relating to notice, agenda, and minutes of meetings,
14 and such other requirements as may be necessary, shall also be
15 governed by the respective ordinances, rules, or procedures of
16 the county council, neighborhood commission, or neighborhood
17 boards."

18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
