
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY RIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-893, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3 "(1) A person commits the offense of use of a computer in
4 the commission of a separate crime if the person either
5 intentionally uses a computer to obtain control over the
6 property of the victim or knowingly uses a computer to identify,
7 select, solicit, persuade, coerce, entice, induce, or procure
8 the victim or intended victim of the following offenses:

- 9 (a) Section 707-726, relating to custodial interference in
10 the first degree;
- 11 (b) Section 707-727, relating to custodial interference in
12 the second degree;
- 13 (c) Section 707-731, relating to sexual assault in the
14 second degree;
- 15 (d) Section 707-732, relating to sexual assault in the
16 third degree;
- 17 (e) Section 707-733, relating to sexual assault in the
18 fourth degree;

- 1 (f) Section 707-751, relating to promoting child abuse in
- 2 the second degree; [~~and~~]
- 3 (g) Section 712-1215, relating to promoting pornography
- 4 for minors[~~-~~];
- 5 (h) Section 708-830.5, relating to theft in the first
- 6 degree; or
- 7 (i) Section 708-831, relating to theft in the second
- 8 degree."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
