# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT ENTERTAINMENT PRODUCTS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by  
2 adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read  
3 as follows:  
4           "§ - Sale of adult entertainment products; view. (a)  
5 Any person or business selling adult entertainment products on  
6 premises open to the public shall obscure the products from view  
7 from off the premises. Adult entertainment products sold on the  
8 premises shall be segregated from other products sold on the  
9 premises, if any, and, by use of a curtain, screen, or other  
10 device, shall be obscured from view from parts of the premises  
11 where other products are sold.  
12           (b) For purposes of this section:  
13           "Adult entertainment product" means any product designed,  
14 or primarily used for, the sexual gratification of the user  
15 including, but not limited to, videos, devices, and novelty  
16 items of an explicit sexual nature.  
17           "Premises" means any building, structure, or place, or any  
18 separate part or portion thereof.

1 (c) Those who violate this section shall be fined \$100 for  
2 each violation."

3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
5 begun, before its effective date.

6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2006.
