## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF HISTORIC OLD  
NAHIKU SCHOOL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The old Nahiku school, in the district of Hana,  
2 TMK: second division 1-2-02:23, was more than fifty years old  
3 and qualified as a historic property. It was a treasure of the  
4 community until it was unfortunately destroyed recently by a  
5 fire. The site remains undeveloped and unused. The Nahiku  
6 community needs a place to gather and share Hawaiian cultural  
7 experiences such as hula, la`au lapa`au, and other cultural and  
8 historic matters.

9           The purpose of this Act is to:

- 10           (1) Enter the old Nahiku school site on the Hawaii  
11 registry of historic places;
- 12           (2) Require the department of land and natural resources  
13 to construct a replica of the old Nahiku school, to be  
14 made available to the Nahiku community for community  
15 activities; and



1           (3) Make an appropriation for the improvement of the site  
2                   and the construction of a replica of the old Nahiku  
3                   school.

4           SECTION 2. The old Nahiku school site, in the district of  
5 Hana, Maui, TMK: second division 1-1-02:23, is entered into the  
6 Hawaii registry of historic places.

7           SECTION 3. After consulting with residents of the Nahiku  
8 community, the department of land and natural resources is  
9 directed to redevelop the site by providing the necessary  
10 infrastructure and constructing a replica of the old Nahiku  
11 school on the site. The department of land and natural  
12 resources shall make the old Nahiku school replica available to  
13 the Nahiku community to gather and share Hawaiian historical and  
14 cultural activities.

15           SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general  
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                   , or so  
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for  
18 development of a replica of the old Nahiku school, in the  
19 district of Hana, Maui, TMK: second division 1-1-02:23.

20           SECTION 5. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the  
21 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of  
22 this Act.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
