
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007.

10 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for capital improvement
11 projects authorized in this Act shall not lapse at the end of
12 the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made;
13 provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as June
14 30, 2005, shall lapse as of that date.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
