
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WAIANAE COAST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that increased use of
2 beach parks and state boating facilities between Kalaeloa and
3 Kaena significantly impacted traditional commercial fishing
4 activities and other non-commercial ocean recreation activities.
5 To reduce the negative impact, the legislature enacted Act 6,
6 Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, to designate an ocean
7 recreation management area and rules. Before designating
8 boundaries for an ocean recreation management area, a baseline
9 environmental study must first be conducted but funding for a
10 study was not available at the time Act 6 was enacted and
11 further action was put off until a funding source could be
12 found.

13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
14 department of land and natural resources to conduct a baseline
15 environmental study of the Waianae coast.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to conduct
2 a baseline environmental study of the Waianae coast.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
