
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) [~~In order to~~] To obtain a permit or a permit renewal,
4 the owner of a vessel shall provide, at the owner's own expense:

5 (1) A marine surveyor's inspection no more than two years
6 old, certifying that the surveyor has inspected the
7 vessel and considers it to fulfill the requirements
8 set by the department; [~~and~~]

9 (2) Documentation that the person is the owner of the
10 vessel. [~~The documentation shall meet requirements~~
11 ~~established by the department.~~]; and

12 In the case of vessels over forty feet in length or
13 weighing over two tons, documentation that the vessel
14 is covered under a marine insurance policy in an
15 amount sufficient for the recovery or disposal of the
16 vessel in the event it sinks or goes aground in near-
17 shore Hawaiian waters; provided that until January 31,
18 2012, this paragraph shall apply only to vessels



1 moored in Ala Wai, Maalea, Nawiliwili, and Honokohau
2 harbors.

3 Any documentation under this section shall meet
4 requirements established by the department."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on February 1, 2007.
