## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAI`I HISTORY MUSEUM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawai`i has many  
2 historical sites that tell the story of a particular group of  
3 people or a place, such as the Battleship Missouri, the Hawai`i  
4 Maritime Center, the Plantation Village, and the Mission Houses,  
5 to name a few. Each site tells the story from a certain  
6 perspective, like spokes on a wheel. There is no place,  
7 however, that provides a comprehensive perspective on the  
8 history of the various peoples and cultures that make up our  
9 island home, no "hub" to the spokes. A centralized institution  
10 that could provide the gathering point from where visitors and  
11 citizens alike could find connection and direction to the  
12 various "spokes" in the wheel would help to further the  
13 appreciation for our rich and diverse communities. The purpose  
14 of this Act is to appropriate funds for the creation of the  
15 Hawai`i Museum of History.

16           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_, or so much




1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the  
2 creation of the Hawai'i Museum of History.

3 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the  
4 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of  
5 this Act.


6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
