
A BILL FOR AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE FIFTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$155,776,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2006-2007 for the following capital improvement projects:

3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.


6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated in section 1 shall be
7 expended as follows:

- 8 (1) Items 1 and 2: department of accounting general
9 services.
- 10 (2) Items 3 through 12: department of education.
- 11 (3) Items 13 through 15: department of health.
- 12 (4) Items 16 through 19: department of transportation.
- 13 (5) Item 20: department of agriculture.
- 14 (6) Item 21: department of land and natural
15 resources.
- 16 (7) Item 22: Housing community development
17 administration of Hawaii
- 18 (8) Item 23: department of Hawaiian home
19 lands

20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
