
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT HILO
NORTH HAWAII EDUCATION RESEARCH CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The North Hawaii education and research center
2 will serve as a catalyst for the educational and informational
3 needs of the North Hawaii region that includes an effective
4 service area from Laupahoehoe to Waimea/Waikoloa. The North
5 Hawaii education and research center will facilitate access to
6 higher education and community outreach and provide a university
7 presence in North Hawaii for community service and research.
8 The North Hawaii education and research center will also
9 facilitate student entry into higher education in an area
10 undeserved by higher education. The North Hawaii education and
11 research center is a unique and important piece in the economic
12 recovery plan for the area and an idea derived by a series of
13 community discussions in North Hawaii.

14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$62,390, or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
