# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS PERTAINING TO KAUAI  
COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007:

5           A.    Nursing and business education building, natural  
6                sciences building, and fine arts building  
7                Design and construction to retrofit or replace air  
8                conditioning system.

7 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the  
 8 University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
