A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 12-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) No candidate's name shall be printed upon any
4 official ballot to be used at any primary, special primary, or
5 special election unless a nomination paper was filed in the
6 candidate's behalf and in the name by which the candidate is
7 commonly known. The nomination paper shall be in a form
8 prescribed and provided by the chief election officer containing
9 substantially the following information:

10 (1) A statement by the registered voters signing the form
11 that they are eligible to vote for the candidate;

12 (2) A statement by the registered voters signing the form
13 that they nominate the candidate for the office
14 identified on the nomination paper issued to the
15 candidate;

16 (3) The residence address and county in which the
17 candidate resides;

- 1 (4) The legal name of the candidate, the name by which the
- 2 candidate is commonly known, if different, the office
- 3 for which the candidate is running, and the
- 4 candidate's party affiliation or nonpartisanship; all
- 5 of which are to be placed on the nomination paper by
- 6 the chief election officer or the clerk prior to
- 7 releasing the form to the candidate;
- 8 (5) Space for the name, signature, date of birth, [~~social~~
- 9 ~~security number,~~] and residence address of each
- 10 registered voter signing the form, and other
- 11 information as determined by the chief election
- 12 officer; provided that use of a registered voter's
- 13 social security number shall be prohibited;
- 14 (6) A sworn certification by self-subscribing oath by the
- 15 candidate that the candidate qualifies under the law
- 16 for the office the candidate is seeking and that the
- 17 candidate has determined that, except for the
- 18 information provided by the registered voters signing
- 19 the nomination papers, all of the information on the
- 20 nomination papers is true and correct;

1 (7) A sworn certification by self-subscribing oath by a
2 party candidate that the candidate is a member of the
3 party;

4 (8) A sworn certification by self-subscribing oath, where
5 applicable, by the candidate that the candidate has
6 complied with the provisions of article II, section 7,
7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii;

8 (9) A sworn certification by self-subscribing oath by the
9 candidate that the candidate is in compliance with
10 section 831-2, dealing with felons, and is eligible to
11 run for office; and

12 (10) The name the candidate wishes printed on the ballot
13 and the mailing address of the candidate."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
