A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that the
2 terms of a customer's health club contract with the seller of a
3 health club is honored by a purchaser of the health club.

4 SECTION 2. Chapter 486N, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
6 and to read as follows:

7 "§486N- Health club contracts upon sale of health club.

8 Upon the sale of a health club, the purchaser of the health club
9 shall assume all liabilities of the health club, including any
10 liability arising under a contract entered into by the seller of
11 the health club."

12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
