# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IDENTITY THEFT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and  
3 placed in Part V, to read as follows:

4           "§92-    Public records; social security number.   Effective  
5 July 1, 2007, all governmental agencies of the State or its  
6 political subdivisions may continue to collect, create, or  
7 maintain records or documents containing an individual's social  
8 security number in the course of carrying out the agency's  
9 legitimate government functions or responsibilities, but shall  
10 not display the social security number in any public record or  
11 document available for public inspection."

12           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.



**Report Title:**

Identity Theft; Public Records

**Description:**

Prohibits all governmental agencies of the State and county from displaying an individual's social security number contained in all records or documents available for public inspection that are collected, created, or maintained by an agency beginning 7/1/07. (CD1)
