# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-110, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 "(e) No holder of a temporary instruction permit shall  
4 ~~operate~~:

5 (1) Operate a motorcycle or a motor scooter during hours  
6 of darkness ~~[or carry]~~;

7 (2) Carry any passengers~~[-]~~; or

8 (3) Use any type of cell phone, including a hands-free  
9 system, while operating a motor vehicle."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
