## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER SPECIAL FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to assist the  
2 counties in addressing the litter problems that is pervasive our  
3 State.

4           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the deposit  
5 beverage container special fund the sum of \$500,000, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for a  
7 grant-in-aid to the City and County of Honolulu for litter  
8 control.

9           SECTION 3. The sum in section 2 shall be expended by the  
10 City and County of Honolulu for the purposes of that section.

11           SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the deposit  
12 beverage container special fund the sum of \$200,000, or so much  
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for a  
14 grant-in-aid to the County of Hawaii for litter control.

15           SECTION 5. The sum in section 4 shall be expended by the  
16 County of Hawaii for the purposes of that section.

1           SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the deposit  
2 beverage container special fund the sum of \$200,000, or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for a  
4 grant-in-aid to the County of Maui for litter control.

5           SECTION 7. The sum in section 6 shall be expended by the  
6 County of Maui for the purposes of that section.

7           SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the deposit  
8 beverage container special fund the sum of \$200,000, or so much  
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for a  
10 grant-in-aid to the County of Kauai for litter control.

11          SECTION 9. The sum in section 8 shall be expended by the  
12 County of Kauai for the purposes of that section.

13          SECTION 10. The counties shall report on their use of  
14 their grants-in-aid to the Legislature twenty days prior to the  
15 convening of the Regular Session of 2008.

16          SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the deposit  
17 beverage container special fund the sum of \$500,000, or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to the  
19 Department of Health to assist the dealers in the implementation  
20 of the deposit beverage container program.

**SB. NO. 2350**

DEPARTMENT: Health

TITLE: RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER SPECIAL FUND.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this measure is to assist the counties by funding litter control programs by counties, their contractors, or their volunteers.

MEANS: Amend Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION: Grants-in-aid

The bill provides for the transfer of amounts from the deposit beverage container special fund to the counties for litter control and for spending in their discretion. The counties shall report on their use of the grants to the 2008 Legislature. There is also an appropriation to the Department of Health to assist the dealers in the implementation of the deposit beverage container program.

GENERAL FUND: None.

OTHER FUNDS: Deposit Beverage Container Special Fund.

PPBS PROGRAM DESIGNATION: None.

OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES: City and County of Honolulu, Counties of Maui, Kauai and Hawaii

AFFECTED BUSINESS: Beverage dealers.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Upon approval; grants-in-aid to counties, on July 1, 2006.
