S.B. NO. 2573

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GASOLINE DEALERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. For decades, published gasoline prices always
2 contained a fraction of a cent. Years ago, when gasoline was
3 twenty cents a gallon, this fraction of a cent made some
4 marketing sense. Today, with gasoline prices hovering at \$3 per
5 gallon, adding a fraction of a cent to the price makes no sense.

6 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the marketing of
7 gasoline with prices containing a fraction of a cent.

8 SECTION 2. Chapter 486H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
10 and to read as follows:


11 "§486H- Gasoline pricing. No gasoline dealer shall set
12 the retail price of gasoline with a price containing a fraction
13 of a cent."

14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
