
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A BASELINE ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY OF
THE WAIANAЕ COAST OCEAN AREA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In 2005, the legislature found that the growing
2 population of west Oahu and the visitor industry are affecting
3 the traditional uses of the area along the Waianae coast, and
4 are having cumulative economic, environmental, social, and
5 cultural effects on the many communities along that coastline.

6 Accordingly, by Act 6, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2005,
7 the legislature mandated the department of land and natural
8 resources to prepare a baseline environmental study as an
9 informational document to be used to establish the boundaries of
10 an ocean recreation management area and to draft ocean
11 recreation management area rules. However, limited state
12 resources prohibited funding for the baseline environmental
13 study at that time.

14 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for the
15 completion of a baseline environmental study of the Waianae
16 Coast ocean area.



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
4 the completion of a baseline environmental study of the Waianae
5 Coast ocean area in accordance with Act 6, Special Session Laws
6 of Hawaii 2005.

7 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
8 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
