A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Campaign contributions shall not be used for personal
4 expenses or to qualify for public funding in any subsequent
5 election, and shall not be transferred to another candidate as
6 prohibited in section 11-200. Contributions shall be used for
7 the office sought by the candidate and shall not be used by the
8 candidate in an election for a different state or county office
9 without the contributor's written consent.


10 Where [~~such~~] contributions are used for the purchase or
11 lease of consumer goods, vehicles, equipment, and services that
12 provide a mixed benefit to the candidate, they shall be reported
13 to the commission pursuant to sections 11-212 and 11-213."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
