A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 249, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 **"§249- Exemptions for members of the national guard and**
5 **reserves.** Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a
6 passenger motor vehicle owned by a member of the Hawaii national
7 guard or federal reserves domiciled in Hawaii, who is in good
8 standing, shall be exempted from any taxes or fees required
9 under this chapter in a manner similar to the exemption for
10 nonresident military personnel under the Servicemembers' Civil
11 Relief Act. This exemption shall not extend to a vehicle used
12 for commercial purposes, nor to more than one vehicle owned by a
13 Hawaii national guard or federal reserve member."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
