
A BILL FOR AN ACT

WAIPAHU CENTENNIAL MEMORIAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In 1996, \$220,000 was appropriated for the
2 planning and construction of a memorial incorporating an
3 existing memorial in Waipahu to honor veterans who lost their
4 lives in World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam
5 War, and Operation Desert Storm, of which \$20,000 was expended
6 for planning. However, with the change of administration in
7 2002, the remaining \$200,000 lapsed. In order to honor the
8 service of our brave veterans who have made the ultimate
9 sacrifice, this effort should not be allowed to falter.

10 The purpose of the Act is to appropriate funds for the
11 planning and construction of the Waipahu centennial memorial.

12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
15 the planning and construction of the Waipahu centennial
16 memorial.

17 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
18 department of defense for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
