
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER'S LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The examiner of drivers can require a road test
2 that measures a driver's functional ability to safely operate a
3 motor vehicle. Only drivers with a valid license or instruction
4 permit may take a road test. Applicants whose driving privilege
5 is under review may not have a valid license or instruction
6 permit after failing the road test on their first attempt.

7 The purpose of this Act is to provide the examiner of
8 drivers with the authority to issue an instruction permit to
9 allow this applicant the opportunity to practice driving while
10 accompanied by a licensed driver and to make additional attempts
11 to pass the road test for licensing.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
14 and to read as follows:

15 "§286- Special temporary instruction permit. An
16 applicant for a driver's license who undergoes and fails the
17 actual demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle under
18 section 286-108(a), if the demonstration was recommended by the



1 medical advisory board pursuant to section 286-4.1, may be
2 issued a special temporary instruction permit, upon the approval
3 of the medical advisory board, entitling the applicant, while
4 having the permit in the applicant's immediate possession, to
5 drive a motor vehicle upon the highways for a period of one
6 year. The holder of a special temporary instruction permit
7 shall be accompanied by a licensed driver at all times while
8 driving. Upon receipt of an updated medical report from the
9 medical advisory board about the applicant, which indicates that
10 the applicant has a prospect of obtaining a driver's license,
11 the applicant may apply for renewal of the special temporary
12 instruction permit for a period of ninety days."

13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
