A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§132D-3 [Permissible uses of non-aerial]~~ Non-aerial
4 common fireworks[-]; permissible uses and prohibitions. (a)

5 Non-aerial common fireworks may be set off, ignited, discharged,
6 or otherwise caused to explode within the State only:

7 (1) From 9:00 p.m. on New Year's Eve to 1:00 a.m. on New
8 Year's Day; from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Chinese New
9 Year's Day; and from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the
10 Fourth of July; or

11 (2) From 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. as allowed by permit
12 pursuant to section 132D-10 if the proposed cultural
13 use is to occur at any time other than during the
14 periods prescribed in paragraph (1);

15 provided that the purchase of not more than 5,000 individual
16 non-aerial common fireworks commonly known as firecrackers shall
17 be allowed under each permit.



1 (b) It shall be unlawful to sell or use non-aerial common
 2 fireworks on the Fourth of July in counties with populations
 3 over 500,000."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
