A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$27,325,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the fifth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Maalaea Small Boat Harbor, Maui

8 A. Pump out station

9 Design \$100,000

10 Construction \$2,500,000

11 B. Ferry system improvements

12 Construction \$13,365,000

13 Total funding \$15,965,000

14 2. Mala Wharf, Maui

15 Dredging \$250,000

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 12 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 13 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 14 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 17 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 18 designated expending agency as follows for the purposes of this
 19 Act:

20 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 and 2 shall be
 21 expended by the department of land and natural
 22 resources for the purposes of this Act.



1 (2) The sums appropriated in items 3 to 8 shall be
2 expended by the department of education for the
3 purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
