
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
EIGHTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$15,280,001, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the eighteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Waipahu Elementary School

8 New 8-Classroom Building

9 Design \$700,000

10 Equipment \$50,000

11 Construction \$9,250,000

12 Total funding \$10,000,000

13 2. Waipahu Community Media Center

14 Design \$250,000

15 Land \$1

21 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
5 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
