A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules.**

4 ~~[Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no county shall~~
5 ~~enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks, except~~
6 ~~as required in this chapter, that is inconsistent with or more~~
7 ~~restrictive than, the provisions of this chapter. Any~~
8 ~~ordinances and rules regulating fireworks that were enacted or~~
9 ~~adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except those~~
10 ~~provisions which are not inconsistent with, or more restrictive~~
11 ~~than those of this chapter, are declared void.] A county shall~~
12 ~~comply with this chapter unless the county council passes an~~
13 ~~ordinance providing for regulation that is as restrictive or~~
14 ~~more restrictive than this chapter. If a county passes an~~
15 ~~ordinance that contains less restrictive provisions, these~~
16 ~~provisions shall be void.~~"

17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
