
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LIBRARIAN POSITIONS AT WAIALUA
LIBRARY AND KAHUKU PUBLIC SCHOOL LIBRARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Waialua library
2 and the Kahuku public school library each have one half-time
3 children's librarian position. The legislature further finds
4 that the current situation at these libraries necessitates the
5 establishment of a full-time children's librarian position with
6 full benefits at each library.

7 The purpose of this Act is to create and fund two full-time
8 children's librarian positions, one for the Waialua library and
9 the other for the Kahuku public school library.

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for
13 the establishment of one full-time librarian III position (1.00
14 FTE) at the Waialua library, and one full-time librarian III
15 position (1.00 FTE) at the Kahuku public school library.

16 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
17 department of education for the purposes of this Act.
