A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
5 for the continued operation of the department of education
6 student transportation program.

7 SECTION 3. Contract services for bus services and the
8 necessity to use fiscal year 2005-2006 funds to make payment for
9 fiscal year 2004-2005 invoices have created a critical funding
10 emergency for fiscal year 2005-2006. The department of
11 education will not have sufficient funds to pay for
12 transportation services with the current appropriation amount.
13 An emergency appropriation is needed to fund the program for the
14 first year of the biennium.

15 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,785,448 or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2005-2006.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 education for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
