A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of
2 education federal revenue maximization program was established
3 to develop a claiming process for all medicaid-eligible health
4 services that it provides to Hawaii's school-aged children.

5 The legislature also finds that moneys generated from the
6 revenue maximization program would be deposited into the general
7 fund. However, the deposit of generated revenue into the
8 general fund does not guarantee the moneys would be dedicated to
9 the school-based claiming program.

10 The establishment of a revolving fund for the federal
11 revenue maximization program would provide a clear nexus between
12 the revenue generated from the school-based claiming program and
13 the provision of those services.

14 The purpose of this Act is to create a revolving fund for
15 the collection and disbursement of generated revenue to support
16 the administration and operations of the federal revenue
17 maximization program.



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Federal revenue maximization program revolving
5 fund. (a) There is established in the state treasury the
6 federal revenue maximization program revolving fund to be
7 administered by the department.

8 (b) The federal revenue maximization program revolving
9 fund shall consist of:

10 (1) Federal revenue collected by the department for
11 administering and operating the school-based claiming
12 program;

13 (2) Legislative appropriations;

14 (3) All interest earned on the deposit or investment of
15 moneys in the federal revenue maximization program;
16 and

17 (4) Any other moneys made available to the federal revenue
18 maximization program revolving fund from other
19 sources."

20 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
