A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$46,367,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
4 purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh
5 senatorial district, as follows:

6 1. To be expended by the department of

8 A. Hanapepe library, Kauai

10 to renovate existing library.

5 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
6 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
7 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
8 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
9 of June 30, 2 , shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
11 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
12 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
