# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELAND SECURITY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. There is appropriated from grants from the  
2 United States Office for Domestic Preparedness and State  
3 Homeland Security Program the sum of \$45,000,000 or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for:
- 5           (1) An assessment of the threat of terrorist incidents;
  - 6           (2) The development of plans to deal with terrorist  
7           incidents;
  - 8           (3) Training and exercises to implement such plans;
  - 9           (4) The procurement of equipment, materials, and supplies  
10           essential to meet the potential threats of  
11           conventional, chemical, biological, radiological, and  
12           nuclear weapons.
- 13           SECTION 2. The department of defense shall submit to the  
14 legislature for approval a homeland security plan consistent  
15 with policies established by the legislature for homeland  
16 security.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
