# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PERTAINING TO THE CIVIL AIR  
PATROL.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the civil air patrol  
2 provides necessary disaster relief, search and rescue, homeland  
3 security, and medical emergency transport services to local and  
4 national organizations. As a peacetime auxiliary of the Air  
5 Force, the Hawaii civil air patrol remains an active volunteer  
6 organization with approximately five hundred fifty members,  
7 including two hundred cadets. The Hawaii wing has three primary  
8 missions: search and rescue, aerospace education, and the cadet  
9 program. It is also an active participant in counter-drug  
10 operations for the Drug Enforcement Agency, flying over one  
11 hundred seventy-nine missions in 2003.

12           The legislature further finds that maintenance and repair  
13 projects are a necessity for successful rescue missions and the  
14 Hawaii civil air patrol depends on state funding to meet its  
15 basic needs. The purpose of this Act is to make an  
16 appropriation for the Hawaii civil air patrol to repair the roof  
17 hangar at the Hawaii wing headquarters.



1 SECTION 2. The following sums or so much thereof as shall  
 2 be sufficient to finance the project listed in this Act, are  
 3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
 4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2006-2007:

5	Hawaii civil air patrol, Oahu	
6	Design and construction to repair the roof hangar at	
7	the Hawaii wing headquarters.	
8	Design	\$1,000
9	Construction	\$74,000
10	Total funding	\$75,000

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the  
 12 department of defense for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital  
 14 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 16 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
 17 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
