# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 304-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3           "(b) The board may charge resident and nonresident tuition  
4 fees for regular courses of instruction at any University of  
5 Hawaii campus, including any community college.

6           The board may also charge other fees for special programs  
7 of instruction, as well as laboratory fees, course fees, fees  
8 for student activities, and an information technology user fee.  
9 The board may charge other fees for summer session or evening  
10 courses, including differential fees for nonresident students.

11           The board may [waive]:

12           (1) Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the  
13 other fees for graduate teaching and research  
14 assistants[~~. The board may enter~~];

15           (2) Enter into agreements with government and university  
16 officials of any other state or foreign country to  
17 provide for reciprocal waiver of the nonresident  
18 tuition and fee differential[~~. The board may waive~~];

- 1        (3) Waive the nonresident tuition and fee differential for
- 2                selected students from Pacific and Asian jurisdictions
- 3                when their presence would be beneficial to the
- 4                university or the State~~[. The board may waive]~~;
- 5        (4) Waive entirely or reduce the tuition fee or any of the
- 6                other fees for students, resident or nonresident~~[.];~~;
- 7                and
- 8        (5) Charge resident tuition fees for members of the Hawaii
- 9                national guard and their authorized dependents,
- 10               without regard to their state of legal residence.

11 The board shall determine the percentage of allowable tuition  
 12 and fee waivers for financial need and other university  
 13 priorities. These tuition waivers and waivers of the  
 14 nonresident tuition and fee differential shall be awarded in  
 15 accordance with guidelines established by the board."

16        SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

**Report Title:**

University of Hawaii; Board of Regents; Tuition; Military

**Description:**

Authorizes the UH board of regents to charge resident tuition fees for members of the Hawaii national guard and their authorized dependents, without regard to legal state residency; eff. 7/1/2050. (SD1)
