
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§323F- Chief procurement officer. There shall be a
5 chief procurement officer for the corporation to manage the
6 procurement of the corporation consistent with chapter 103D.
7 The administrator of the state procurement office may delegate
8 authority to the chief procurement officer as appropriate and
9 necessary to maintain a level of patient care that is consistent
10 with best practices in the medical profession. The chief
11 procurement officer shall:

12 (1) Seek the advice of the administrator of the state
13 procurement office on matters pertaining to
14 procurement; and

15 (2) Not hold any other management or executive position
16 within the corporation.

17 The corporation board shall employ and dismiss at its pleasure
18 and fix the compensation of the chief procurement officer. The



1 chief procurement officer shall be exempt from chapters 76 and
2 89."

3 SECTION 2. Section 103D-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

5 "(a) The chief procurement officer for each of the
6 following state entities shall be:

7 (1) The judiciary--the administrative director of the
8 courts;

9 (2) The senate--the president of the senate;

10 (3) The house of representatives--the speaker of the house
11 of representatives;

12 (4) The office of Hawaiian affairs--the chairperson of the
13 board;

14 (5) The University of Hawaii--the president of the
15 University of Hawaii;

16 (6) The department of education, excluding the Hawaii
17 public library system--the superintendent of
18 education; [~~and~~];

19 (7) The Hawaii health systems corporation--the person
20 specified in section 323F- ; and

21 [~~(7)~~] (8) The remaining departments of the executive branch
22 of the State and all governmental bodies

1 administratively attached to them--the
2 administrator of the state procurement office of
3 the department of accounting and general
4 services."

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
