A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Mililani's seventeenth senatorial district
2 encompasses the new and expanding area of Mililani Mauka and the
3 oldest part of the town, including the town center. Rapid
4 development has caused chronic overcrowding in the newest
5 schools, which resulted in Mililani High School's population
6 burgeoning to over 2,500 students. A barely functioning phone
7 system at Mililani High School has created a frustrating and
8 unsafe situation. Built on an area the size of several city
9 blocks, the campus must have a reliable phone system for the
10 health and safety of the students.

11 In recent years, the legislature has funded a new ten-
12 classroom building at Mililani High School. In 2003, \$360,000
13 was appropriated for design, and another \$5.7 million was
14 appropriated in 2004 for construction. Due to the increased
15 costs of construction and labor costs, an additional
16 appropriation will be needed to complete the project.



1 In addition to the needs of the newer schools and the high
 2 school, the original Mililani schools are nearly forty years
 3 old. These schools have many issues, including repair and
 4 maintenance, as well as facilities that are outdated and in need
 5 of restoration.

6 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
 7 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$13,016,600, or so much
 8 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
 9 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
 10 2006-2007, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
 11 the seventeenth senatorial district, as follows:

1 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvements project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
5 of June 30, 2008, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
8 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
